## Joint Resolution

## To establish the fourth Sunday of July as "Parents' Day".

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the fourth Sunday of every July shall be established as "Parents' Day" to be recognized as a recurring, perennial day of commemoration.

SEC. 2. RECOGNITION.

All private citizens, organizations, and governmental and legis-lative bodies at the local, State, and Federal level are encouraged to recognize Parents' Day through proclamations, activities, and educational efforts in furtherance of recognizing, uplifting, and supporting the role of parents in the rearing of their children. Approved October 14, 1994.
